Minutes from CIH staff meeting Monday 27/1-2014:

First, Astrid Blystad and Karen Marie Moland spoke about mixed methods, and how to include this even more as a method at CIH.

2. CIH and research groups

Bente Moen takes us through the suggested model for research groups; with CIH as an umbrella—a cluster-including the different research groups which have been identified:

- Reproductive health, child health and nutrition
- Climate and health? (Malaria)
- IKT and health management?
- Groups partly at IGS and partly at CIH: the priority setting group, the global health anthropology group and Arbeids- og Miljø-medisin
- (Bergen Respiratory Research Group, belongs to K2; but will be related to CIH)

These names are only suggestions, part of the draft. The leader of each Research Group (a Senior researcher) should have a large amount of responsibility for the scientific development in the group, but the HR-aspects will be the responsibility of the CIH leader.

CIH research school: 1 person from each research group at CIH plan each semester together: Midway seminars and other gatherings for PhD- students. CIH leader will lead the school, and be responsible for initiating these activities.

CISMAC is not put into the model as it has researchers in several groups.

A pdf of Rolv Terje Lies presentation regarding research groups is also enclosed; to see the purpose of these.

3. Economy

An overview of the economy from 2013 is enclosed (in Norwegian) and a suggestive budget for 2014. The discussion revealed many unsolved challenges, and the enclosed file will be revised by Moen and Mykkeltvedt.

Research groups registered at the latest tomorrow will be given "their" part of the incentive funding allocated for this purpose at IGS (1.5 mill NOK in total). Researchers at CIH who are not member of a research group will receive 20 000 NOK in 2014.

4. Teaching

Next Monday (February 3) at 1400 the agenda will be to follow up on some of the ideas from the Annual Education Day for the course leaders. It is important to take into account the input from the program sensor.
