**Overview:**

This course consists of three sub-courses that together cover a broad range of quantitative research methods and statistical analysis techniques. The three sub-courses are:

1. March 10-12, 2014: Survey construction and measurement. Course leaders: Gisela Böhm (UiB), Torbjørn Torsheim (UiB), Ann Bostrom (University of Washington, USA)
2. March 13-17: Experimental design and analysis. Course leaders: Bjørn Sætrevik (UiB), Finn Konow Jellestad (UiB)
3. March 19-21, 2014: Multivariate methods for PhD students. Course leaders: Nora Wiium (UiB), Åge Diseth (UiB), Robert Smith (UiB)
