### **Subject 11/23 Matters of information**

#### Admissions

International admissions (outside EU/EØS): There were 211 applications, of which 88 were sent to the Admission Committee at CIH (AC) for professional assessment. 75 were found qualified. In addition, the Division of Student and Academic Affairs at UiB (SA) found 2 qualified and 121 applicants unqualified.

EU/EØS/Switzerland: There were 21 applications, of which 13 were sent to AC for professional assessment. 11 were found qualified. SA found 2 qualified and 3 unqualified.

National Master admissions: Deadline 15 April.

NORPART project students: 4.

# Internal evaluation of the Master Programme in Global Health

Follow up Subject 8/23 – The decision was that the subject would be discussed at CIH's Strategi day 24 March, which it was. # Subject 12/23 Annual course evaluation, spring 2023

The coordinator of the courses "Experimental epidemiology" (INTH321A) and "Qualitative research methods for global public health" (INTH323O) have submitted course evaluations. The other course coordinators should do the same (Encl. 4).

**Suggested decision:** The course coordinators for INTH328B, and INTH356 should submit their annual evaluations asap. (<u>Eigenevaluering av emne</u> (<u>arleg</u>)). The coordinators for INTH331A INTH345 and INTH360 should submit them when the courses are finished.

# Subject 13/23 Three-year course evaluations

In accordance with UiB's Quality System for Education, in addition to annual evaluations of individual courses, more comprehensive course evaluations should be carried out every three years. The Program Committee should make a plan for course evaluation so that all courses have completed a more thorough evaluation, including student evaluation, during a three-year period. The course coordinators are responsible for the evaluation of their courses, that a student evaluation is carried out, and to analyze and follow up the results, including preparing proposals for improvement measures. The courses which are due for evaluation this spring are INTH310A and INTH314. There is a special template (Encl. 5).

**Suggested decision:** The course coordinators for INTH314 and INTH310A should complete the evaluations.

Students who receive the grade "F" are allowed to re-sit according to standard procedures at the University of Bergen.

The course coordinator Ingunn M.E. Engebretsen also wishes to implement the same changes for INTH360. The present assessment is a portfolio of a written examination, a group report and an individual report.

**Suggested decision:** The Committee approves of the changes in assessment of the course INTH360A and INTH360. The changes will come into force from spring 2024.
