

## ACADEMIA AGREEMENT – MOBILITY FUNDS (FAGLIG UTVEKSLING)

We are pleased to invite applications for funding of academic activities related to the four strategic areas given in the Academia Agreement between the University of Bergen and Statoil.

The application deadline is September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2016 and the activity applied for must take place by June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2017.

Scientific staff at UiB and PhD students may apply for:

- 1) Travel to conferences, seminars and workshops related to the strategic areas for up to NOK 25 000. Priority will be given to participation with presentation (oral and/or poster). Funds are not for educational purposes and funding for field work is not eligible.
- 2) Invitation of a guest researcher to UiB for up to NOK 25 000 (for travel and living expenses).

Strategic areas in the Academia agreement 2016:

1. Prediction of reservoir properties from seismic and well studies
2. Unconventional resources
3. Energy transition
4. Geothermal energy

Please note that all applicants must give acknowledgment to Statoil on talks or posters that are presented to conferences funded by the Academia Agreement. Regarding visiting scientists UiB applicants should ensure that the visiting guest researcher is introduced to the relevant Statoil environment, and are encouraged to propose a guest lecture at Statoil, in addition to a guest lecture at the University of Bergen, which should be announced for Statoil. Please use your own department contacts at Statoil to organize such an event. The committee will use approximately two weeks to evaluate the applications.
