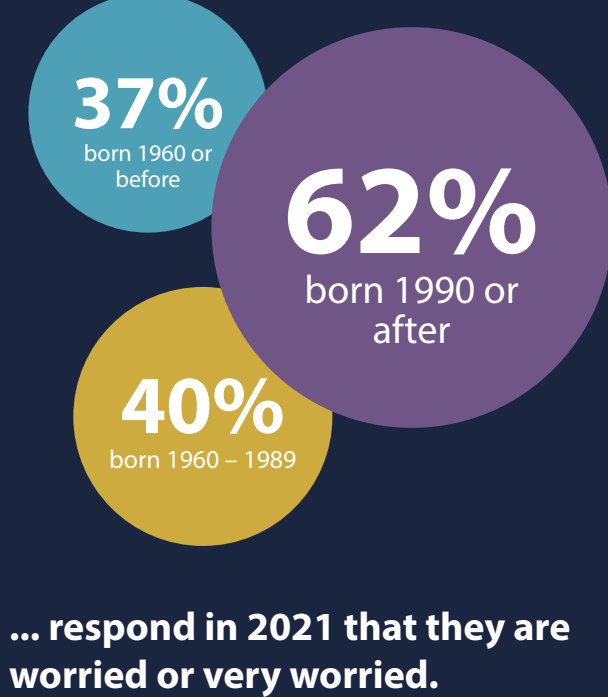
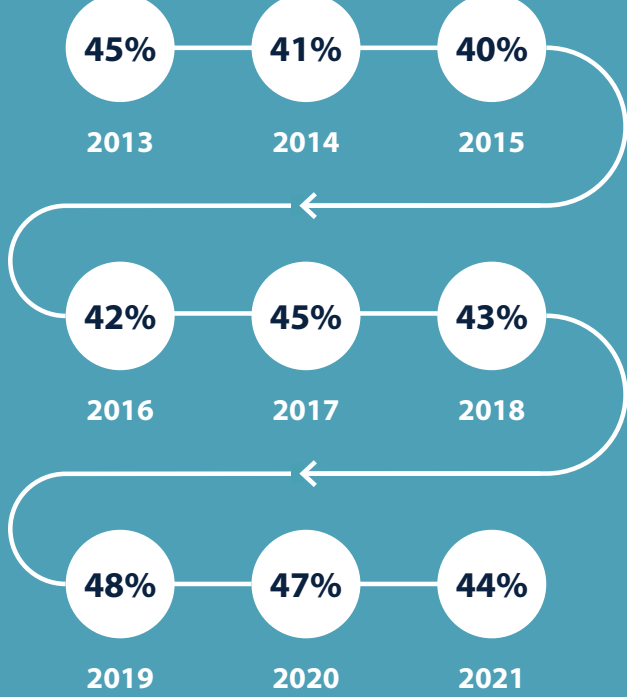

All data is collected in 2021 unless otherwise specified.



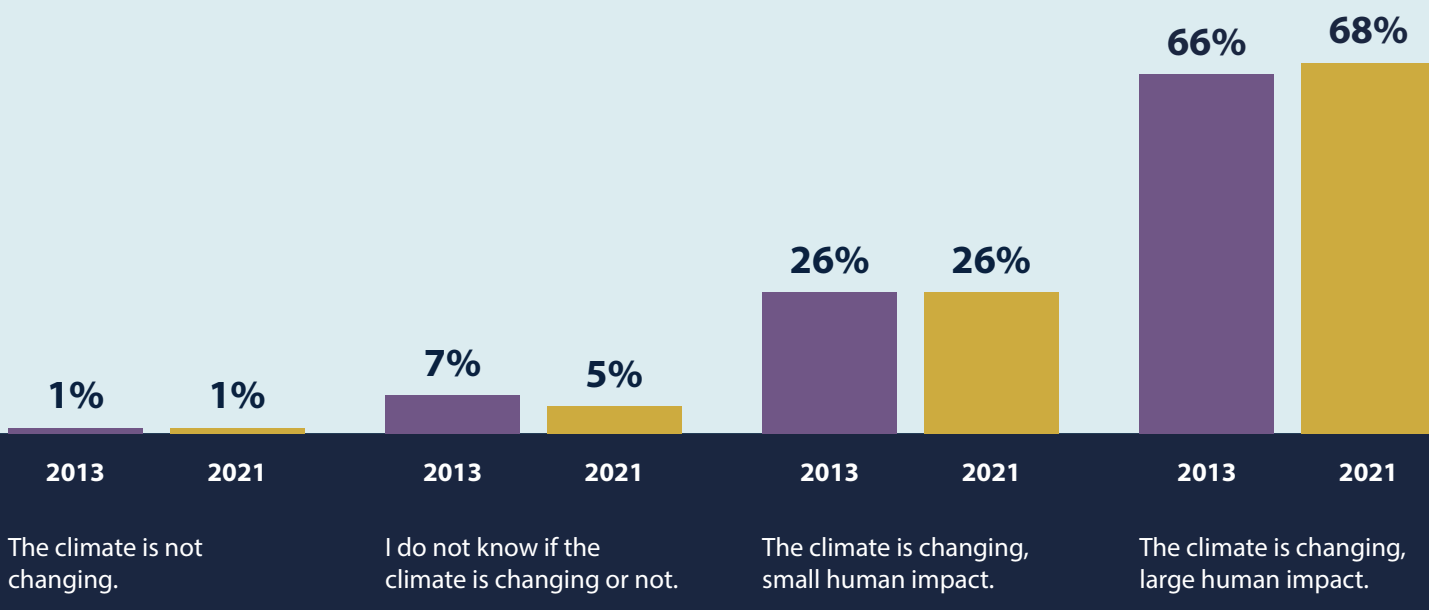
## How worried are norwegians about climate change?

... respond in 2021 that they are worried or very worried.

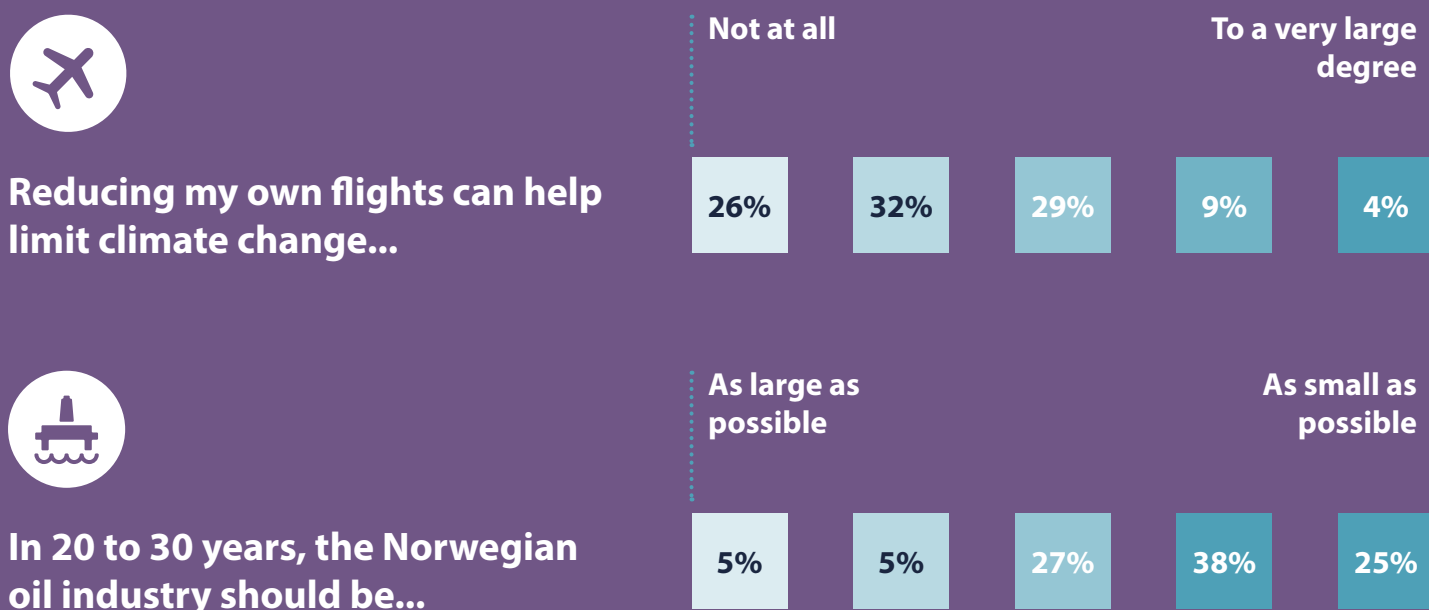
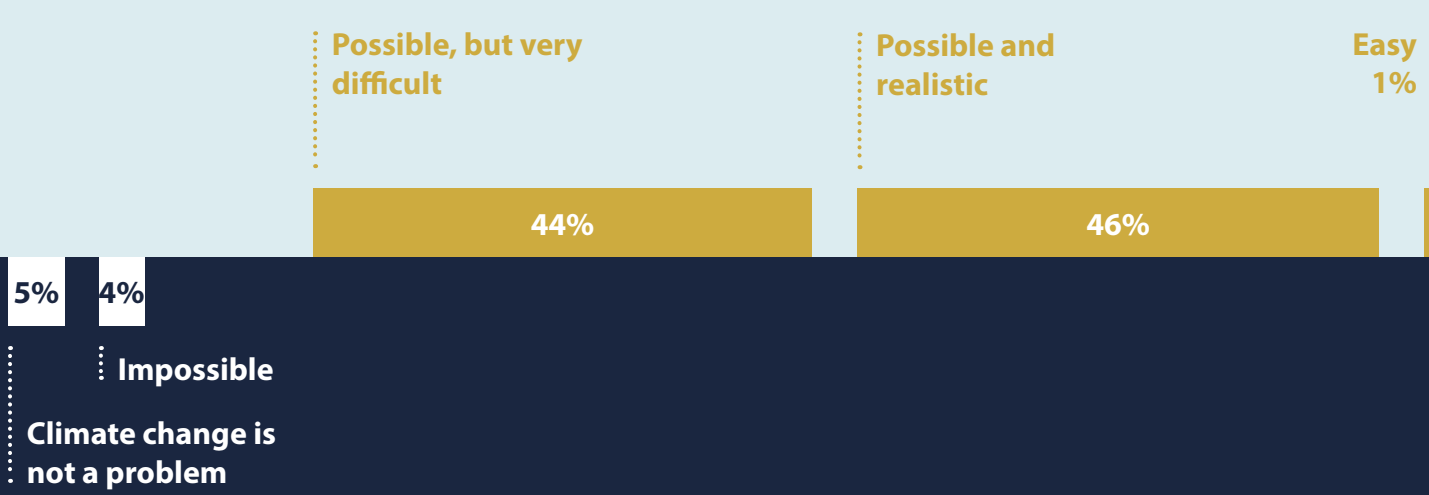
## Most people think that the climate is changing and that climate change is mostly due to human activities.



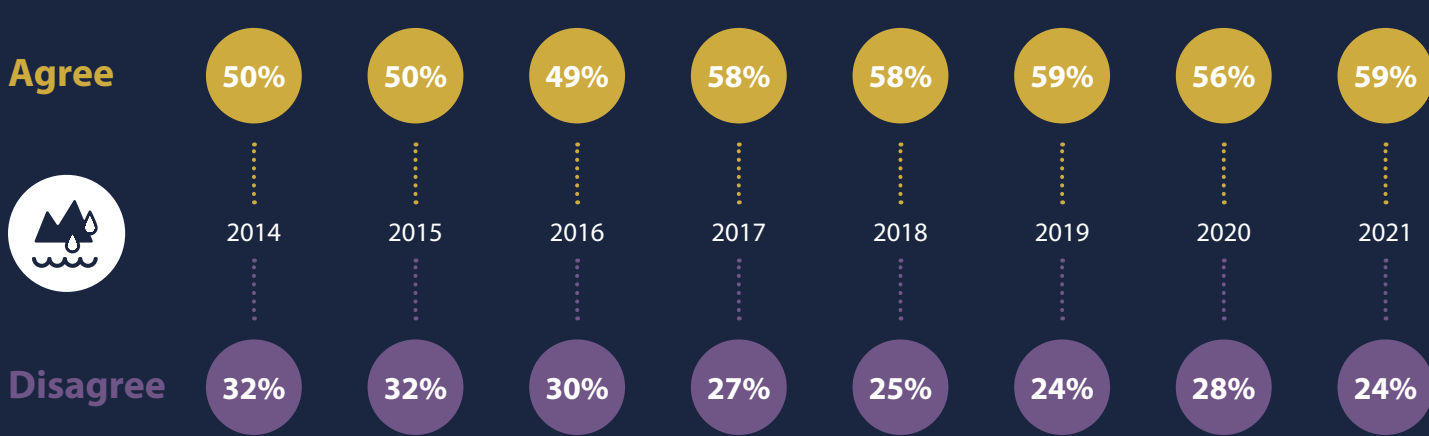
## How severe is the climate threat?



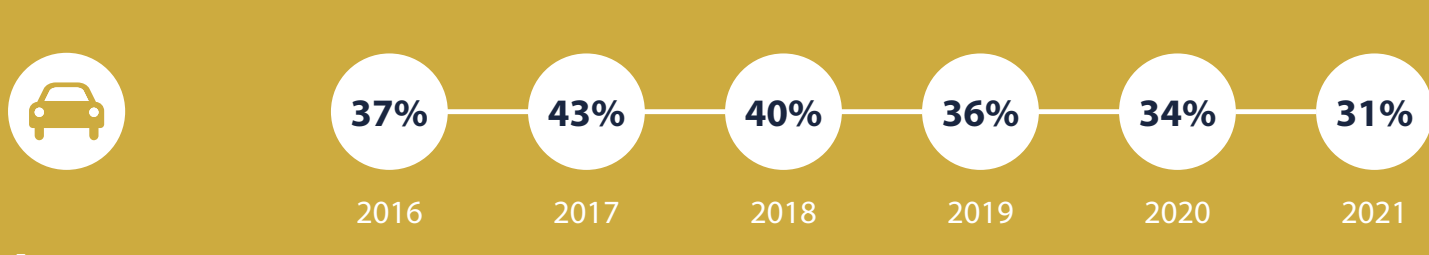
## Most people think it's possible to prevent harmful climate change...
