Dr. Charlotte Faircloth is a Senior Lecturer in the Department of Social Sciences at Roehampton University in London, and a Visiting Scholar and founding member of Center for Parenting Culture Studies. She completed her PhD at the Department of Social Anthropology, exploring women's experiences of attachment parenting and 'full-term' breastfeeding in London and Paris. She is interested in cultures of parenthood; notions of body, gender and equality in care-giving and its implication for other relationships; and more broadly in knowledge claims around optimal forms of care. As well as editing several journal special issues, she recently co-edited a volume entitled 'Parenting in Global Perspective: Negotiating ideologies of kinship, self and politics', for Routledge, and is co-author of 'Parenting Culture Studies' published by Palgrave.
