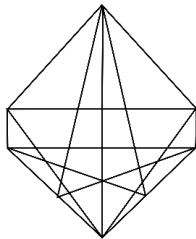
Transparency, Policy Outcomes, and Political Support in Local Government

Presentation by Pedro Magalhães, researcher at Institute of Social Sciences (ICS) at the University of Lisbon.

Magalhães will talk about research on process-outcome interactions, and present two papers dealing with local government in Portugal. One based on a survey experiment which suggests that transparency, impartiality, and voice are all important, but transparency is the one that moderated the relationship between outcome favourability and political support.

A second where they use observational data on local government transparency, and show that, in the more transparent municipalities, people are less likely to reward short-term benefits and focus instead on long-term ones.

Papers will be sent out with the invitation, so those interested can read them.
