### Dear Colleagues,

I'm very pleased that we've finalized the recruitment of a new faculty member and that Morten Øygarden will be joining us at the Selmer center from early December! We are in the process of interviewing for a new position in the Visualization group and will soon announce a tenure track position in optimization. It is important for us to recruit new faculty to maintain high-quality research and education – and to be able to spread the workload on several staff members.

Several groups need strengthening through new recruitment. However, we also need to be careful not to overstretch our economy. We need to work on both increasing our income side, mainly through educational activities and external funding, and to reduce expenses where possible. This is the reason why we have initiated a process to see if we can reduce our office area. This year, we will use around 13 000 000 NOK on renting space. I know that we have quite a number of unused offices and desks and believe it will be possible to cut this expense guite considerably. Many of our sister departments at the Faculty of Science and Technology have already gone through similar processes, and there is a big process at the

medical faculty to reduce the money spent on rent. We are not in an acute situation, but I believe we should start the process now and that we may be able to save costs corresponding to one or two extra faculty members.

Of course, we need to ensure that we all still have a good office situation with good work environment for our staff – and also space for guests and students. We want to have a process that is transparent and as fair as possible so that we maintain the good atmosphere at the department where everybody supports each other with a strong sense of belonging. I know that such a process can be challenging so we will need to use a bit of time and give everybody

ample opportunity to provide input and wishes in the process. I encourage all of you to come to our all-staff meeting on October 23<sup>rd</sup>.
