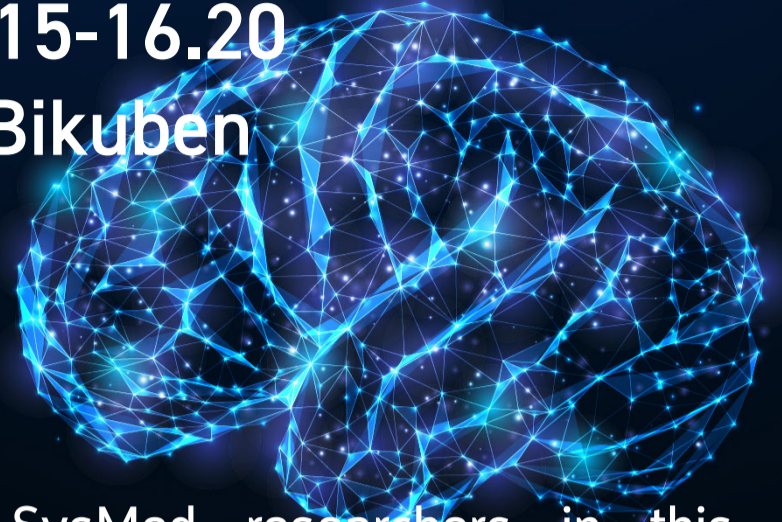



Junior Scientist Symposium
