A short introduction from the Fine Art and Design Library


## What is Oria

Oria is a search engine that helps you explore printed and electronic collections at the University of Bergen Library and other university and college libraries in Norway. With Oria you can search for books, articles, journals, music, movies, photographs and more. Go to [uib.Oria.no](http://uib.Oria.no) or start searching in the simple search box at the University of Bergen Library's homepage.




## Oria simple search

Type one or more keywords in the search box. It is possible to combine words and phrases in different ways.



To search for a specific expression or a specific book title, use **quotation marks**, i.e. "the eyes of the skin".

An asterix in the end of a word include alternative endings of the word. Wood\* includes woods, wooden etc.



Also try Boolean operators AND, OR, NOT for smart searching.

## Checking availability and physical location

When the search is done you will get a list with references to articles, books, pictures, dvd-s, book chapters and other documents. The list contains information about availability and (for printed documents) physical location.


## Finding a book in the library

*Street furniture design* is available at the Fine Art and Design Library (Bibliotek for kunst og design). The signature is UBBKD **717 Her**.

The signature is a classification number followed by one or more letters. The classification number expresses a topic. You find the signature at the back of the book.


If you are a student at The Institute of Design or The Art Academy (at KMD) you are supposed to go to the Fine Art and Design Library and find the book on the shelves. If you need assistance the librarians are happy to help.



## Lending a book

Most of the library's books can be borrowed for a period of one month. If no one else places a hold on the item, the loan will be automatically renewed for up to 4 months. You will get an email from the library when it is time to return. Kindly note that if you don't return after you got several messages, there is a risk of getting a replacement-fee that you have to pay even if you return the book later. ## Sending a request / placing a hold

*Paying the land* is checked out. If you want to read this book it is important that you place a hold on it. You do this by sending a request.



Click on the record to get the *sign in* option. When you are signed in, you can send a request.



You will get an email when the book arrives. Your pickup location is mentioned in the email. Follow the same procedure if you wish to borrow a book that are physically located at any of the other University of Bergen libraries and you wish to have it sent to the Fine Art and Design Library. It will take approximately two days to get it, and you get an email when it arrives.

## Books available online



In this case the book is delivered by “Ebook Central Academic Complete” and you must create a personal account on their digital platform to be able to download the book on your mobile device.

This is free when you are connected to the UiB-net via VPN or if you are logged in to EZ-proxy from <https://login.pva.uib.no/login> (google “pva.uib.no” – and you are there)
