



Non-recyclable waste

- Food waste
- Dirty plastic or paper
- Paper cups and paper plates
- Napkins
- Styrofoam
- Hard plastic and all plastic not used as packaging
- Mixed packaging, i.e. windowed envelopes

Other waste

- Paper is sorted in dedicated cardboard boxes in offices or common areas
- Batteries, fluorescent light tubes, electronic waste, printer toner, or larger quantities of paper, plastic or glass, is sorted in the nearest disposal room
- Hazardous waste must be disposed in accordance with UiB's guidelines and local procedures

Plastic packaging

- Plastic bags and plastic foil
- Plastic cups, tubes, boxes or cans used for packaging
- Coffee bags or chips bags etc.
- Plastic bottles (single use)
- All other clean and dry plastic packaging

Please note: Must be clean, rinse with cold water.



Glass and metal packaging

- Tin cans
- Metal corks and lids
- Aluminium trays and foil
- Glass bottles (single use)
- Glass jars

Please note: Must be clean, rinse with cold water.
