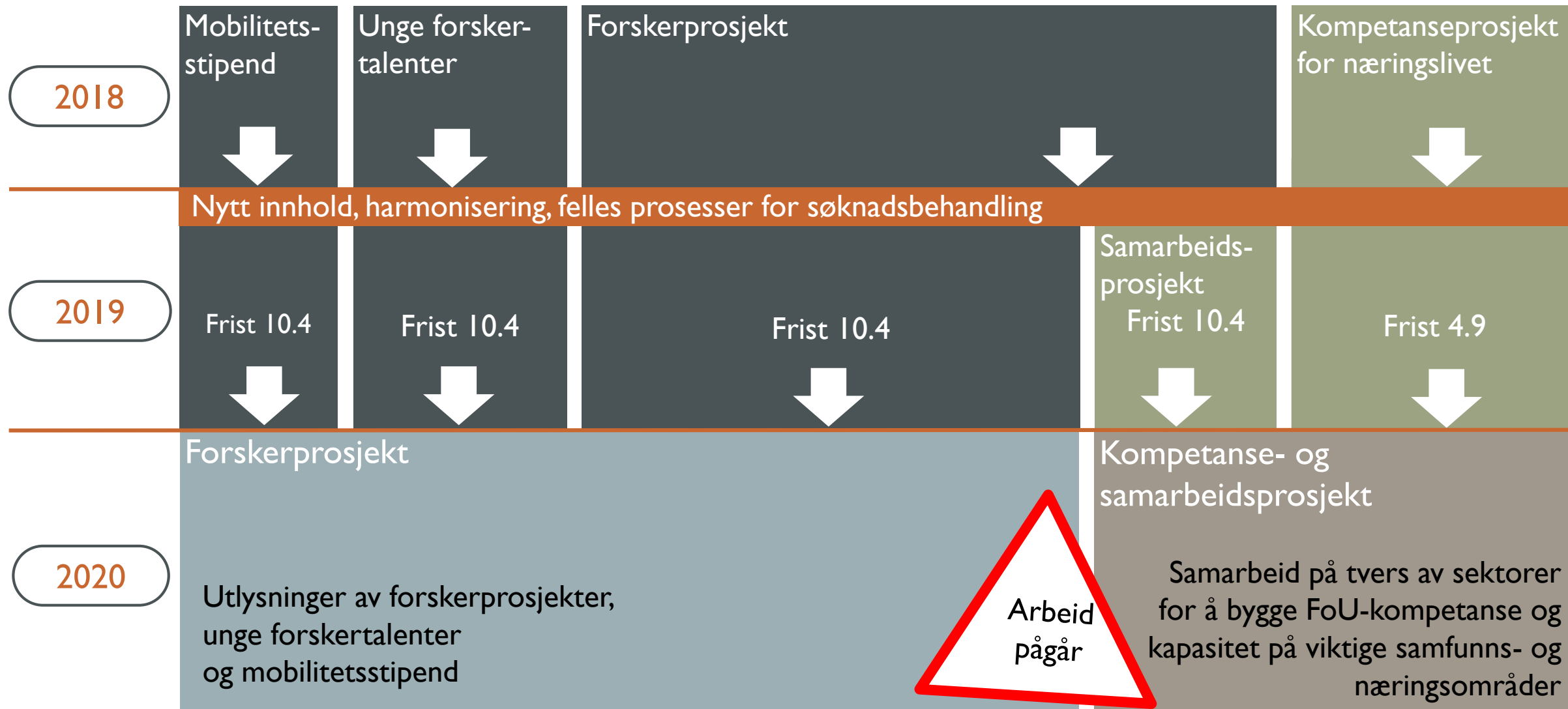

Overgang til nye søknadstyper Forskerprosjekt og Kompetanse- og samarbeidsprosjekt



The application types **Researcher Projects**, **Young Research Talents** and **Mobility Grants** have several features in common:

- they support renewal and development in research across disciplines and thematic areas,
- the project manager must hold a doctorate,
- and **businesses may not** be collaborating partners in the projects.

Requirements relating to the project			
	Project manager	Project duration	Amount sought
Researcher Projects	Approved doctorate or competence at associate professorship level	3–6 years	NOK 4–12 million
Young Research Talents	Minimum 2 and maximum 7 years may have passed since the date of the defence of an approved doctorate. You must be under 40 years old. You may apply to deduct time for statutory leaves of absence from the requirements related to experience and age. You must dedicate at least 25 % of a full-time position to the project.	3–4 years	NOK 4–8 million
Mobility Grants (Other support)	No more than 7 years may have passed since the date of defence of an approved doctorate. You may apply before you submit your thesis. You may apply to deduct time for statutory leaves of absence from the requirement related to experience. As of the application submission deadline, you may not have lived or worked in the country of the host institution abroad for more than 12 months in the past three years.	3 years (2 abroad, 1 in Norway)	NOK 3.0–3.9 million

The application types: **Collaboration Projects on Societal Challenges and Business Development** have several features in common:

- projects are to be carried out by one or more research organizations in binding **cooperation with relevant actors from the private and/or public sectors.**
- projects costs may include costs for project partners
- the project manager must have an approved doctorate or competence at associate professorship level.
- the project duration may be minimum 24 months and maximum 48 months.
- minimum funding amount allowed: **NOK 4 million**

NEW RULES FOR RCN CALLS

- Common web portal per application type [entry](#) (RP,YRT, MG) [entry](#) (CP)
- Programmes/FRIPRO have their own calls
- RCN will be using the same application requirements and assessment criteria across all programmes and activities
- Each call will have its own guidelines / priorities + some additional requirements
- A maximum of two applications may be submitted
- There are no restrictions concerning the number of grant applications in which you may be a participant
- Applications will be reviewed by specialist referee panels

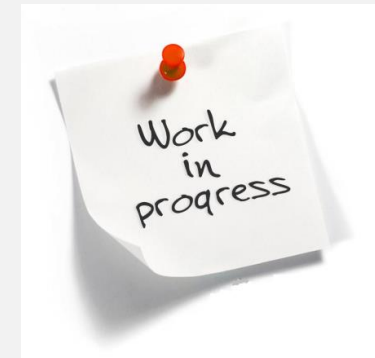

- Ny prosjekt mal:

1. Excellence

- State of the art, knowledge needs and project objectives
- Novelty and ambition
- Research questions and hypotheses, theoretical approach and methodology

2. Impact

- Potential impact of the proposed research
- Measures for communication and exploitation

3. Implementation

- Project manager and project group
- Project organization and management





PLANER FOR SØKNADSBEHANDLING

Strategiske vurderinger og innstilling

1. Etter panelbehandling gjør administrasjonen strategiske vurderinger (inkl. relevans for utlysningen)
2. Noen programmer vil be søker redegjøre spesifikt for hvorfor søknaden svarer på utlysningen (i et eget vedlegg, *Relevance to the call for proposal*)
3. Basert på panelvurdering og strategiske vurderinger lager administrasjonen en innstilling med anbefaling om søknader til finansiering

Beslutning

- De nye styrene beslutter hvilke søknader som skal finansieres
- Dersom samme søknad er sendt til to utlysninger og vedtas finansiert i begge, skal det være en regelbasert mekanisme for hvor finansieringen tas fra

IMPACT FOR YOU

- One deadline → less time writing applications
- More common requirements and templates → easier application process
- Max 2 projects per PI → more equally division of funds/ higher success rate?
- High scientific quality → higher probability of funding (to relevant call)

For help from administration → YOU need to start earlier with the application
