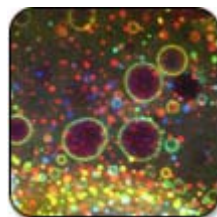

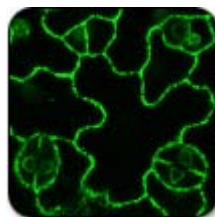
Cell / Tissue Network



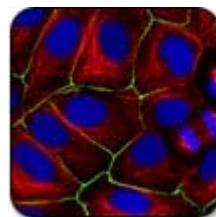
