## **NeuroNor conference**


**NeuroNor invites to the National Meeting "Neuroscience- new methods, treatments, and strategic approaches" .**

**Researchers and students have to report their research projects to NSD, if the projects are subject to notification.**

NSD is the Data Protection Official for 150 research and educational institutions in Norway. Their main tasks include evaluating research projects according to current legislation, and providing advice and guidance on personal data protection in research.

Your project is subject to notification if you will be processing personal data in the following ways:

- using computer-based equipment like text, audio or video files, USB, smartphone and/

or

- manual storing of sensitive data sorted by name or personal identification number



The exploratory pre-seed programme is a stimulus fund established to accelerate commercialization of biomedical research findings and development of novel technologies, drug candidates, devices and diagnostics in the life science area.

The programme seeks to support application-oriented research and stimulate entrepreneurship by funding projects at a very early (pre-seed) stage.

Grants can support activities costing from DKK 100,000 to DKK 500,000 during a grant period of 4-12 months.


